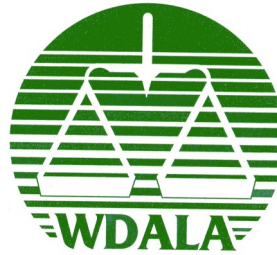

*From Lookback to Payback: Understanding the Medicaid Nursing Home Rules*

Diane K. Lutt guides individuals and families through the estate planning process and also assists families with estate settlement after the death of a loved one. She graduated from Washburn University School of Law in Topeka, Kansas in 2012 and began practicing law in Minot the same year. While at Washburn she was a Research Editor for the Washburn Law Journal and published two articles.

Diane will identify sources of law used to determine Medicaid eligibility for persons over the age of 65 who need help paying for the nursing home, improving client intake and interview skills to assist in identifying relevant Medicaid eligibility and estate recovery issues, and recognizing effective Medicaid planning strategies and common pitfalls in the process.

He graduated from the North Dakota Police Academy in 2004; Criminal Investigator Training Program (CITP) at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC) in 2007; Secret Service Special Agent Training (SSAT) Course in 2007 and; Immigration and Customs Enforcement Special Agent Training (ICESAT) Course in 2012.

Presentation will cover mitigating threats and identifying danger for children as it relates to Internet Crimes Against Children and identifying grooming behavior. SA Trudell will also cover mindset, situational awareness, identifying and disrupting the assault cycle, knowledge and information to make you and your family harder targets.
